## 1- TAKE TIME FOR \_\_\_\_\_

*“There were two blind men setting on the roadside. When they heard that Jesus was passing by they shouted, ‘Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David.’ Then the crowd sternly ordered them to be quiet. But they shouted even more loudly. ‘Have mercy on us Lord, Son of David!’ Jesus stood still and called them saying, ‘What do you want Me to do for you?’ They said, ‘Lord, let our eyes be opened.’ Moved with compassion Jesus touched their eyes. Immediately they regained their sight and followed Him.” Matthew 20:30 – 34*

**“God, give me Your eyes. Show me who to serve.”**

## 2- TAKE TIME FOR \_\_\_\_\_

*“When he reached the place where the road started down the Mount of Olives, all of his followers began to shout and sing as they walked along, praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen. “Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the LORD! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!” But some of the Pharisees among the crowd said, “Teacher, rebuke your followers for saying things like that!” He replied, “If they kept quiet, the stones along the road would burst into cheers!” Luke 19:37-40*

**“God, cause me to understand what You’ve done for me.”**

## 3- TAKE TIME FOR \_\_\_\_\_

*“While Jesus was in Bethany in the home of a man known as Simon the Leper, a woman came to him with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, which she poured on his head as he was reclining at the table. When the disciples saw this, they were indignant. “Why this waste?” they asked. “This perfume could have been sold at a high price and the money given to the poor.” Aware of this, Jesus said to them, “Why are you bothering this woman? She*

*has done a beautiful thing to me. The poor you will always have with you, but you will not always have me. When she poured this perfume on my body, she did it to prepare me for burial. I tell you the truth, wherever this gospel is preached throughout the world, what she has done will also be told, in memory of her.” Matthew 26:6 – 13*

**“God, show me what’s valuable to You.”**

## 4- TAKE TIME FOR \_\_\_\_\_

*“Jesus left the city and went to the Mount of Olives as He often did. His followers went with Him. When He reached the place He said to them, ‘Pray for strength against temptation.’ Then Jesus went about a stone’s throw away from them. He kneeled down and He prayed.” Luke 22:39 - 41*

**“God, help me keep in touch with You all day.”**

## 5- TAKE TIME FOR \_\_\_\_\_

*“When the other disciples saw what was about to happen they exclaimed, ‘Master, shall we fight? We brought along the swords.’ One of them slashed at the high priest’s servant and cut off his right ear. Jesus said ‘Stop. No more of this.’ And He touched the place where the man’s ear had been and He restored it.” Luke 22:49 – 51*

**“God, give me the strength to love the unlovely.”**

*“And you will joyfully give thanks to the Father who’s made you able to have a share in all that He’s prepared for His people in the kingdom of light. God has freed us from the power of darkness and He has brought us into the kingdom of His dear Son. The Son paid for our sins and in Him we have forgiveness.” Colossians 1:12- 14*
